We strongly recommend that you have someone checking your condo in your absence or at least every two weeks when you are gone. Refer to your <u>Manchester House Rules</u> for guidance. 3-24-20 revision.

CLOSING YOUR CONDO

- 1. Change your mailing address. This can be done online or ask your postman for a change of address card.
- 2. Put phone, cable and TV on vacation. Call Spectrum customer service (866.874.2389).
- 3. Cancel the newspaper. *Tampa Times* 813.226.3300.
- 4. Clean or change your air conditioning filter.
- 5. Set air conditioner on 79-80 degrees, fan on automatic, system on cool. (Most AC units operate with 2 AA batteries check yours).
- 6. Close and lock all windows. Close blinds/curtains.
- 7. Unplug all electrical items: microwave, computer surge, phone, all lamps, toaster, coffee maker, etc.

IF NOBODY IS WATCHING YOUR CONDO IN YOUR ABSENCE:

- Toilets: flush, turn off water supply, wrap tank and toilet in plastic wrap to prevent the water from evaporating. This keeps bugs, roaches, etc. from entering through the plumbing system.
 - Close all drains in sinks, tubs and showers by covering with cloth and placing water jars on top. Plug up overflow hole in tub and sinks with steel wool.
 - Turn off water valves under bathroom and kitchen sinks.
 - 8. Open all closet and cabinet doors.
 - 9. Place charcoal briquettes in pie tins in closets and under chairs, sofa (or Damp Rid).
 - 10. Turn refrigerator to lower setting.
 - 11. Empty ice cube maker and lift handle up.
 - 12. Dispose of all cardboard boxes and paper bags (bugs feed on box and bag glue).
 - 13. Store all open and unopen cereal boxes, pasta, coffee, flour, sugar, crackers, spices, etc. in the refrigerator if you leave it on. Otherwise get rid of all food items that are not canned or in sealed jars.
 - 14. Dishwasher clean all dishes and keep door shut.
