

To Unit owner's with Emotional Support or Service Animals: The Association is required to maintain appropriate documentation of all Emotional Support Animals or Service Dogs in residence. Please ensure that you have provided the following documentation by January 1, 2020:

Service Dog:

- Copy of Service Animals registration
- Copy of Florida license and photo of animal
- Copy of required Florida vaccinations

Emotional Support Animal (ESA):

● Copy of Emotional Support Animal letter - As per the Air Carriers Access Act and Fair Housing Amendment, you are required to have a valid letter from a licensed doctor or mental health expert that shows a need for your emotional support animal. This letter must have a date on it and will be only valid for one year. The letter must be printed on the professional's letterhead, including the professional's type and state of licensure, and documents that

- (a) the client has a mental or emotional disability as defined by the DSM**,
- (b) the client needs (i.e., not wants, prefers, or would benefit from) the ESA to travel, and
- (c) is under the care of the mental health professional (U.S. Department of Transportation, 2010).

- Copy of Florida license and photo of animal
- Copy of required Florida vaccinations

Note - both dogs and cats are licensed in Gulfport, FL.

Owners are responsible for the prompt clean-up of waste materials. This information must be provided every year that the animal is in residence. Please make sure your documentation is up-to-date.
