Each and every unit has a "notifier" installed per order of the City of Gulfport Fire Marshall. NEVER unplug or remove your notifier. If you do, it will start ringing an alarm and will cost you \$232.00 (\$400.00 on a weekend) to have CSS come out to "fix the problem". If you intend to turn off all of your electricity, please notify a member of your Board of Directors. He/she will know what to do so that you can turn off your electricity.

You will also want to advise any of your friends or relatives staying in your home not to touch or unplug this notifier.

When you have relatives or friends stay in your condo during your absence, please give written notice of their names to a Board Member per filed documents in OR Book 6622, at Page 1748, Article X, R. "Owners ....must inform the Association in writing of the name(s) of any guest authorized to use their apartment during their absence."
